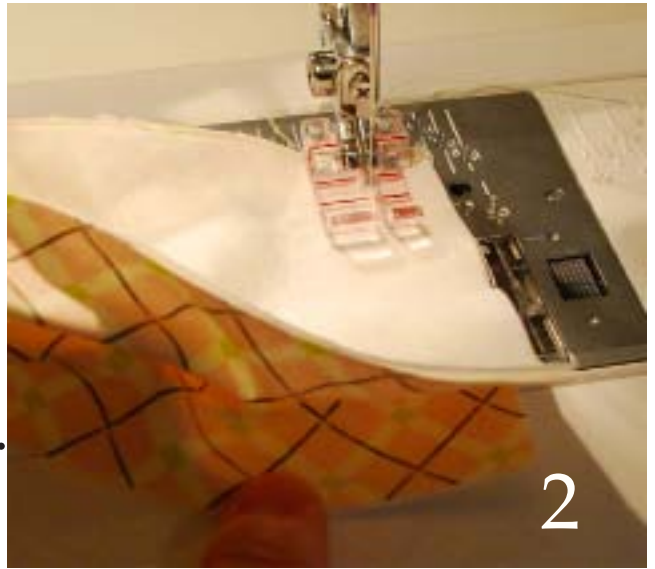


Prepare to Sew

1. Slide the key ring onto the fabric.

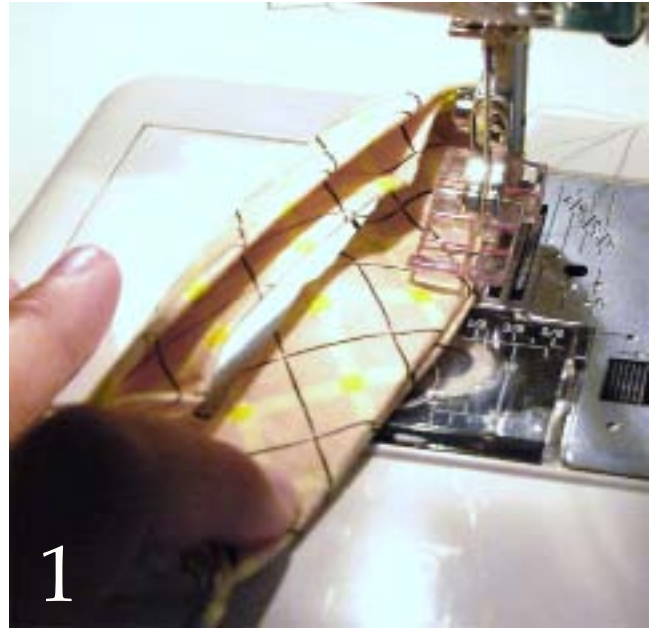
2. Open the ends of the fabric. Make sure you're making a loop that is not twisted. Match the raw short ends of the fabric, right sides together, and stitch them together using a 1/4" seam allowance. Don't be confused by my picture, I used 1/2" that time, but have decided that 1/4" seam allowance would be less bulky.

3. Fold the fabric back together and you should have a circle with the key ring on it.



Time to Sew

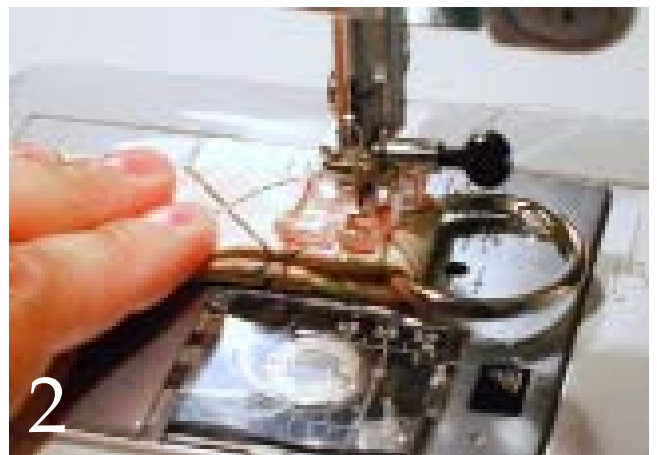
1. Now you're going to finish the fob by stitching along the open side of the loop using a 1/8" seam allowance. Be careful not to slip off of the edge.



2. Slide the key ring to the spot in the loop that has the seam from stitching the loop together. Pinch the fabric close around the key ring and stitch it to create a stable pocket for the key ring.



If you like, slide your lobster clasp onto the key ring like you would a key. Now you can clip to your Ruffle Wristlet. Pattern in the shop soon.
